

The IN2WORK program stretches across 22 states and is easily implemented at both the large state DOC and local municipal and county jails.



<u>1,545</u>

There are currently 1,545 students enrolled in the IN2WORK food and retail programs.



<u>4,500+</u>

Over the past 10 years, the I2W Program has more that 4,500 graduates successfully complete the program.



<u>16</u>

We have awarded 16 I2W scholarships to graduates of the program. Levels of study including bachelors, associates and technical degrees/certifications.

Today, there are 52 interns working in our Aramark kitchens – earning minimum wage while incarcerated.

Aramark has hired 19 graduates of the program once they have been released back to the community.
